What is CLIL?

ICTE's CLIL programs are designed for educators who have a language background other than English and who teach, or want to teach, course content using English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI).

The program supports participants to:

- Enhance their ability to teach academic course content in English
- Develop teaching materials that engage learners and support their learning of content and language.
- Use practical skills and techniques to effectively manage the learning process

The program supports universities to:

- Attract international students to campus through the increased delivery of courses taught in English
- Enhance the English language level of local students and prepare them for their own study abroad experience
- Develop their internationalisation strategy and vision.

Program Content

Participants take part in practical workshops and apply practical teaching ideas and strategies to their own teaching materials.

This one week program will cover:

- Active learning activities for the classroom
- Strategies for adapting texts for lecturing purposes
- Strategies for learner engagement managing large classes
